

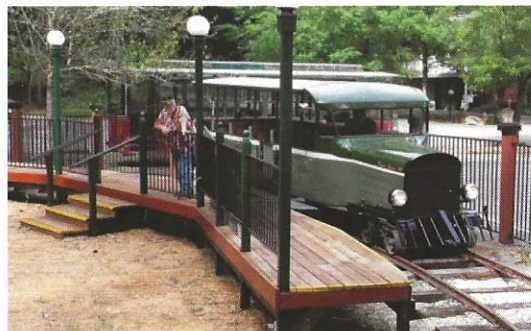

Gift Shop Volunteers greet our visitors, get them started on their tours, help them to ride the Railbus on Saturdays, and process their purchases.

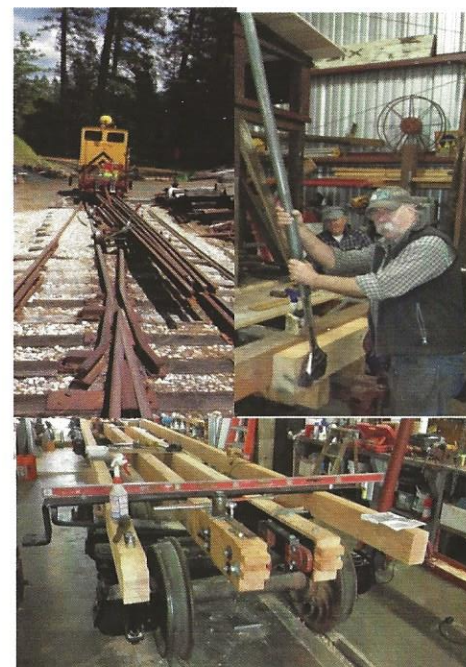


Volunteers help to provide essential financial assistance to our museum. As few as three hours a week will help our cause.

The Narrow Gauge Railroad began operating in 1876 to link the area with the transcontinental railroad in Colfax. The museum contains historic steam engine #5, the **Tahoe**, the first steam car built in Grass Valley, aviation artifacts, buggies, photos, railcars, and equipment. Docent led tours take you through the rail yard, into the large active shop where skilled restoration craftsmen rebuild one-of-a-kind railcars.

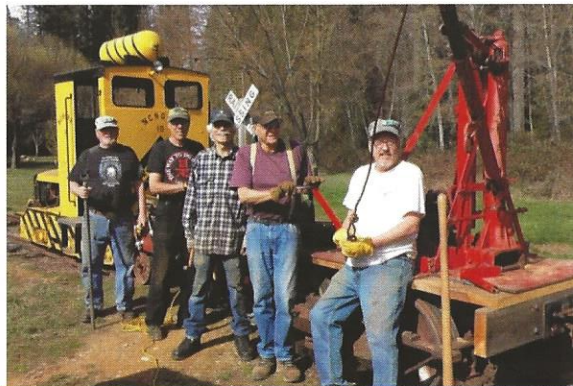
